## MEET THE CHATWIN FAMILY

After six overseas deployments and years of dedicated service with the U.S. Marines, U.S. Army, and U.S. Army Reserve, Sergeant Chris Chatwin's recovery journey began when he was diagnosed with a TBI and a chronic illness resulting from overexposure overseas.

In 2018, Chris was admitted to the ICU for a flare-up that caused him to use a wheelchair for more than two years. His wife, Katie, became a full-time caregiver to not only Chris but also their children Miles, 7, Marlowe, 5, and Maxwell, 3.

Then, Katie found Our Military Kids. With the cost of horseback riding lessons covered, Katie was able to find a local, Veteran-owned equestrian center that was perfect for Marlowe. With her OMK grant, Marlowe could get right back to what she loved in her new town.

*"The equestrian center is a healing place," said Katie. "It's so peaceful. Every day Marlowe asks, 'Do I get to see Hannah [the horse]?' She absolutely loves it. It's just made things so much easier — for Chris to be able to go out there, say hi to another Marine, and just be there with Marlowe. It's just an amazing experience. We are so thankful that Our Military Kids made this happen."*

Katie shared that having the time and space each week to get out of the house, relieve some stress, and connect with their new community has had a significant impact on the whole family.

"It really makes a big difference," said Katie. "On really, really hard days mentally, you wish everything could just be 'normal.' But horseback riding gives us that sense of normalcy. It's good for Chris, it's good for Marlowe, and it's even good for me because it feels like home. Marlowe is really good, too — it just gives her that confidence. It's amazing to see."

## A WARM WELCOME

Dear Friends of Our Military Kids,

What a year! Thanks to all of you, Our Military Kids awarded more than 4,000 extracurricular activity grants totaling \$1.18 million to children with a parent deployed with the National Guard, deployed with the Reserve, or recovering from post 9/11 combat-related injuries.

As we navigated through the second year of a global pandemic, our Board of Directors was strategically focused on ways to increase our support for the families we serve. Expanding our grant criteria to include 3 and 4-year-olds was first on the list. Whether they tumbled, swam, or took ninja classes, our little ones were thriving alongside their older siblings.

Next, we looked at the increasing role of the Guard and Reserve in supporting both overseas and stateside missions. By mid-year, the Board voted to make children of service members deployed domestically or overseas eligible for one \$300 grant for deployments of 90-179 days and two \$300 grants for deployments of 180 days or more.

*"I would say it's all about confidence," said a grant recipient parent. "[My children] were able to participate in extracurricular activities, which helped them further form bonds with friends. It provided them with more opportunities outside of the home."*

From our 2021 survey, we learned 97% of our grant recipient families with a combat injured parent would not have pursued an extracurricular activity for their children without the financial assistance OMK provides. So we added a 5<sup>th</sup> \$300 "FLEX" grant that can be used at any point in the service member's recovery.

*"Due to the impact my service has had on me, I did not maintain activities for myself or my children outside of school," said a Veteran parent. "Therefore, [OMK] has been a great success in socializing them and me. It has also given them the opportunity to do extracurricular activities they would otherwise not be able to due to my restricted financial situation. I am forever grateful for Our Military Kids and don't know where we would be without them!"*

2021 also ushered in OMK's first *Courageous Kids of 2020 Contest* and radically broadened volunteer opportunities with an extremely successful *Share Your Thanks* Campaign. In the campaign, employees of our investors and their families wrote, illustrated, or colored notes by hand to our OMK grant recipients which we began including in their Top Secret award packages. To this effort, we assign the hashtag #priceless.

We thank you for the value you bring to Our Military Kids every day. Your generosity and volunteerism enable us to serve and positively impact the lives of a very deserving group of military kids and teens through activities that melt their stress away. We couldn't do this important work without you!

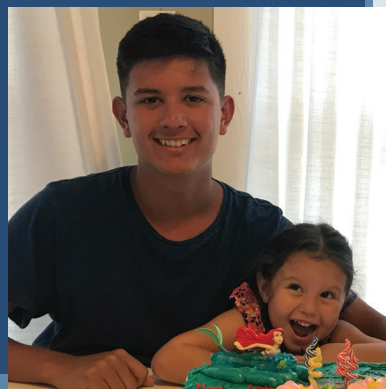

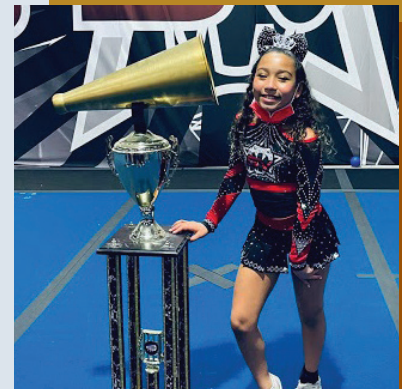

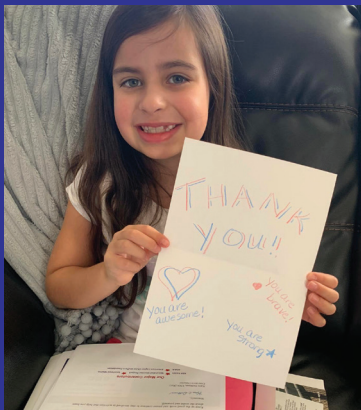

# 2021 HIGHLIGHTS

## #OMKREMEMBERS CAMPAIGN

Our Military Kids launched #OMKRemembers in recognition of the 20th anniversary of the September 11th terrorist attacks and reached our goal of raising \$91,100. This fundraiser provided 300 extracurricular activity grants for military children and teens who are still impacted by the events of 9/11, with parents who have deployed more frequently with the National Guard or Reserve or have faced long journeys to recovery from severe injuries sustained in overseas missions since 2001.

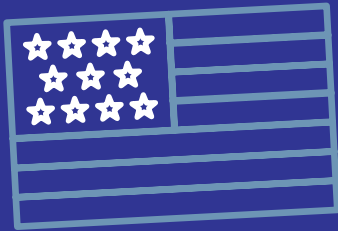

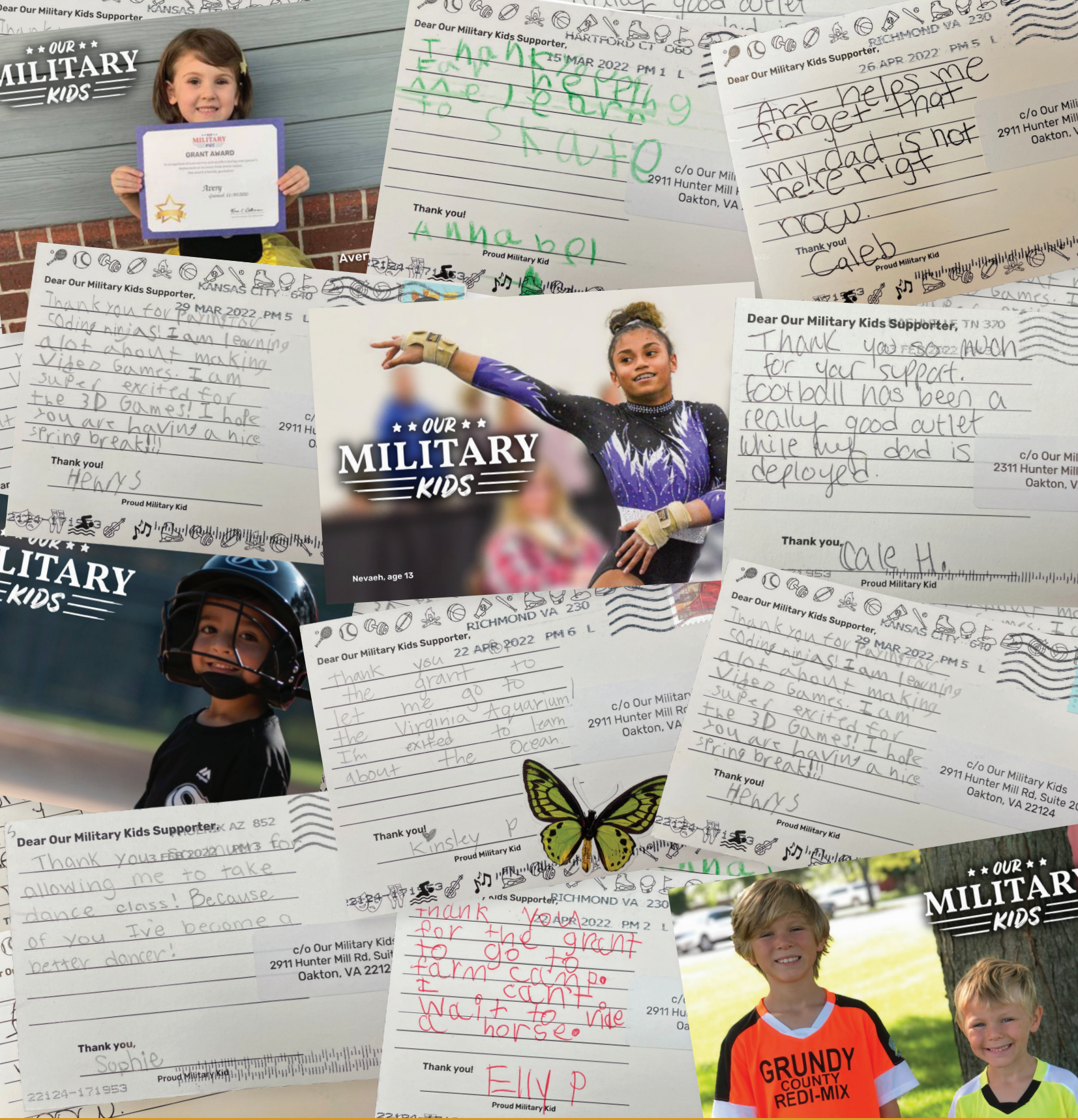
